REPORTS

- **1.Principal's Report-** school is experiencing **significant growth** but so far won't impact Out of School programs/Daycare. At this time, expected Sept enrolment is 236, up from 208. **An 11th division** is being added to Room 16 (currently the Teacher Prep room). There will be some restructuring of various storage rooms to accommodate this.
- -Zone track meet for grades 3/4/5 will be at Uvic, Thurs May 25. City Finals are on June 1st.
- -Whole school field trip to Island View Beach, Wed May 24th. School buses required for trip have been paid for by **Greater Victoria Harbour Authority donation**! We will take a pic of school trip to send to GVHA as a thank you.
- -Next year's **School Calendar** creation in progress. PAC is encouraged to add any known dates.
- -Misha Smart's library mural panels are being sealed and will be mounted in June.
- -**Traffic calming** on Oswego has begun. A Radar speed sign and 2 hinged school zone lane markers are up near school. These welcome improvements are funded by GVHA, and installed by the City. A new crosswalk is to be added to Simcoe and Oswego.
- **2.PAC Chair Report-** Nothing of note to report.
- **3.Treasurer's Report-** because of GVHA's school bus grant, we have extra money in our Gaming fund. Teachers have been encouraged to submit any special requests now! Jeff requests track meet buses are paid for out of this grant (\$504), as well as "practice" bus passes for grade 5's transitioning to Central Middle School (\$25).

Parent Education nights with Mary Kelly – are finished for now, but will continue in the Fall.

June Pac meeting – has been rescheduled to Wed June 21 so as not to conflict with Community Picnic. Corinne will ask Lindsay to update school calendar, and will change bulletin board.

Community picnic, Wed June 14 – PAC will be making and selling popcorn, and Empire Donuts. Tiffany is coordinating, but may not be able to come to the picnic. Corinne, Bruce, Nikki and Laurel have offered to help her. We need extension cord (Corinne can bring). Recommended to arrive 1pm to setup and start making popcorn.

School jerseys/hoodies – Lindsay has ordered new jerseys, with school orca logo. PAC could get involved by selling additional tshirts to parents, as a fundraiser. Jeff suggests pre-ordering. The company would likely supply free sample sizes that we could show at Community Picnic, but general consensus is to wait til Sept to sell them.
