



James Bay Community School Student Placement 2017-2018

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Grade Configuration

At this time, the grade configuration for next year has not been determined, nor have teachers been assigned a division. This will be determined through the student placement process.

Students Leaving James Bay

It is very important that we know of any families who are considering or have made the decision not to return to James Bay in September. These possible shifts in enrolment affect the way we configure our classes. Please notify the office if you are planning to leave James Bay.

Placement of Students

Student placement is based on trust. You need to trust that our goal in organizing our classes is the same as yours - to place each child in an optimum learning environment. We must do this within the constraints of staffing allocations, numbers of boys and girls at each grade level, personalities, etc. In the end, each classroom will have its own character, offering different benefits to each child. Beginning the process with as much information as possible gives us the best chance for successful placements.

If you feel that they have educational information that would help the decision-making process please convey that information in writing (email) to the principal by May 19, 2017. Such information will be utilized as one of the factors staff will consider when forming class lists. Please do not request a specific teacher in your letter. These requests will not be considered.

*Please do not contact teachers or other staff (in person or by phone/email) about class placement. These conversations can put teachers in difficult situations which may violate their Professional Code of Ethics.

Thanks in advance for your input and support. We all want to ensure your child has a successful school experience here at James Bay Community School.
