Babysitting Course (11-15 yrs)



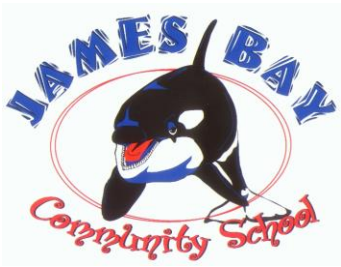

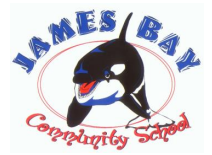
